Tony Brown's musical career spans 40 years. His style of music has diversified while maintaining his musical integrity and has evolved into a high quality professional hybrid of all the cultural, musical experiences of his life,

His R&B and Blues (mixed with gospel and country Blues) background influenced his funk concept which created his own style of "Yank Skank embellished Reggae."

After years of being road musician, production mnager, road manager, and developer at musical events, Tony has now organized his music into a professional business based on the inspirations of his works and experiences.

Tony Brown and his company, Living Nations Productions, was retained as entertainment management for The Angelic Brewing Company in Madison, WI and orchestrated all "Live" music for the venue.

Living Nations Production and Tony Brown represent 28 recording artists from the United States, Belize, Cyprus and Canada. He coordinated and actualized the first week long celebration of the musical works of Bob Marley which was presented in six different venues.

A position on these charts is coveted by all Blues recording artists. To attain this position almost immediately following his CD's release, and at the age of 21, is a distinct honor.



Readers of *Living Blues* magazine's annual Reader's Poll voted singing sensation Shemekia Copeland as Blues Artist Of The Year (Female). Copeland's latest CD, *The Soul Truth*, produced by legendary guitarist Steve Cropper, was widely hailed as the strongest of her career.

A total of six Iowa acts participated in the Challenge.

KUNI Blues Blowout featuring Lil' Ed & Blues Imperials Saturday, November 4

There'll be a whole lotta rattleshakin' goin' on at the legendary Surf Ballroom in Clear Lake on Saturday, November 4 when Lil' Ed & the Blues Imperials roll into town.

Alligator Recording artist Lil' Ed Williams, although small in stature, is a true giant of the Blues, and among the very last authentic West Side Chicago Bluesmen. From smoking slide guitar boogies to rawboned Chicago shuffles to the deepest slow Blues, Lil' Ed Williams is a master Bluesman.

A gifted guitarist and a remarkably gritty and soulful vocalist, Williams, along with his blistering, roadtested band, the Blues Im-

perials, has been tearing up clubs and festival stages all over the world for almost 25 years.

Not since the heyday of Hound Dog Taylor and The HouseRockers has a Chicago Blues band made such a consistently joyous, rollicking noise.


Between the band's wonderfully untamed music and Ed's flying leaps, his back-bending, his toe-walking through the audience and his sliding across the stage on his knees, it's no wonder The Boston Globe called Lil' Ed and The Blues Imperials "the world's #1 houserocking band."

Cedar Rapids' Kevin B.F. Burt & the Instigators open the show. For the past twelve years they have electrified audiences throughout the Midwest. The impressive vocal abilities and pas-






Above, Lil' Ed & The Blues Imperials
